The Use of Temporary Visitors Membership.

Temporary Visitors' Membership is primarily for students who are in the area for a while, but wish to insure but not to licence, as their main Dojo (where they train and grade) is located elsewhere. Restrictions: Restrictions of use include; BWK Gradings, Advancement, Instructing (whether temporary or permanent), Competitions & Tournaments, etc.

Insurances - Cover is for all related activities organised within the **British Wado Federation**. *Cover does not include training elsewhere and does not allow the use of live bladed weapons or kick-boxing.*

Due to the turnover of student memberships in martial-arts it is usually considered that if a martial-arts licence has expired it is normally due to the result of the individual terminating training δ membership etc. A student who allows his/her licence to expire will result in the following:

- 1. Registration card is destroyed after 3 months expiry.
- 2. Kyu grade registration records destroyed after 3 months expiry.
- 3. Insurance cover becomes invalid at time of expiry.
- 4. Membership terminated at time of expiry.

Once reapplication has been accepted all records are replaced.
