## MINIMUM TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:

- SHODAN: From 1<sup>st</sup> Kyu to 1<sup>st</sup> Dan (minimum age 10) = 9 months.
   NIDAN: From 1<sup>st</sup> Dan to 2<sup>nd</sup> Dan (minimum age 12) = 18 months.
   SANDAN: From 2<sup>nd</sup> Dan to 3<sup>rd</sup> Dan (minimum age 18) = 36 months.
- 4. For further *practical grade* intervals, see BWK Constitution.

Dojo training sessions does NOT include private lessons or teaching hours.

NB: There will be a written examination for all Yudan applicants from 1<sup>st</sup> Dan to 3<sup>rd</sup> Dan.

**DO NOT ATTEMPT TO APPLY FOR A GRADE YOU ARE NOT PREPARED FOR.** You must be already conversant with the grade & requirements **PRIOR** to applying, as there will be NO refund through cancellation due to lack of preparation or readiness.

The Chief Examiner will be GE Swift Hanshi. Applications to be received at least **TWO MONTHS** prior to grading date.

#### Requirements.

All BWK members wishing to pursue Yudan Shinsa should have attended the minimum BWK Standardisation/Advancement Courses (please refer to Yūdan Shinsa Application Form) PRIOR to application. Arrangements can be made for clubs geographically disadvantaged.

As with all gradings, all applicants must arrange for their own Uke-Mi and ensure they have all the correct requirements (clean white gi, bogu, etc.) with them for participation.

Also, make sure to bring your up-to-date BWK Licence with you on the grading day. If your licence is out-of-date your grading will be cancelled.

#### Failure/Cancellation of Dan Gradings.

Upon a Dan grade being failed or cancelled (irrespective of written, practical or both) the student must produce the minimum required training record, **FROM ORIGINAL FAILURE/CANCELLED GRADE DATE**, before the retake can be honoured by the Yudan Assessment Panel (retake date can be taken after 6 months from failure date), as long as there are sufficient **OFFICIAL DOJO TRAINING SESSIONS** accumulated 'prior to' application date. However, students may only be required to retake the element/s (written or practical) they have failed on; as long as the retake is implemented 6-months from original failure date (after this date, or if the grade is failed again) both aspects would have to be undertaken).

All applicants MUST apply/reapply using the official **Yudan Shinsa Application Form**, also available from your instructor, British Wadokai Administration Department, or British Wadokai Website/Forum. Allowances can be made for students who require assistance during the written examination, for example; those with certain learning difficulties, dyslexia, etc. However, the BWK General Secretary **MUST** be notified **at least two months prior** to the examination date to make any necessary preparations, etc. In certain cases students may be read the questions as an aural/verbal test condition.

NB: There will be NO refunds as a result of *applicant cancellation*, due to insufficiently prepared to attempt the grade. An applicant should be 100% prepared and ready to grade, at the time of application, which is at least 2-months prior to the grading date.
